The FSA is the independent watchdog that regulates financial services. Use this information to decide if our services are right for you.

## 2. Whose products do we offer?

### Insurance

- We offer products from a range of insurers for private medical expenses insurance, life assurance, critical illness, permanent health insurance, building & contents insurance and accident, sickness & redundancy insurance.
- We only offer products from a limited number of insurers for travel insurance and dental insurance contracts. Ask us for a list of the insurers we offer insurance from.
- We only offer products from a single insurer.

## 3. Which service will we provide you with?

### Insurance

- We will advise and make a recommendation for you after we have assessed your needs for private medical expenses insurance, life assurance, critical illness, permanent health insurance, buildings & contents insurance, accident, sickness & redundancy insurance contracts, dental insurance and travel insurance contracts.
- You will not receive advice or a recommendation from us for private medical expenses insurance, life assurance, critical illness, permanent health insurance, buildings & contents insurance, accident, sickness & redundancy insurance contracts, dental insurance and travel insurance contracts. We may ask some questions to narrow down the selection of products that we will provide details on. You will then need to make your own choice about how to proceed.

## 4. What will you have to pay us for our services?

### Insurance

- A fee
- No fee for advising on and arranging private medical expenses insurance, life assurance, critical illness, permanent health insurance, buildings & contents insurance, accident, sickness & redundancy insurance contracts, dental insurance and travel insurance contracts.

You will receive a quotation, which will tell you about any other fees relating to any particular insurance policy.

## 5. Who regulates us?
